On **Sunday, May 31st** the doors to VGBC will be opened to **In-Person Worship Service**.
The doors will open at **10:45 a.m.**

**Our Security Team and Resident Nurses
have formulated a plan to protect our congregation as best we can.**

1. If you do not, for any reason, **feel comfortable in attending, please continue to use the digital realm to join us for worship. WKMO 99.3, Facebook or VGBC.NET.**
2. For those 70+and those who do not feel comfortable attending Sunday morning service, I will be conducting a study-preaching service each Wednesday at 12:00 in the Sanctuary, beginning June 3.
3. **No** Sunday School or Small Groups meetings in the church during the month of June. **BUT**, we are diligently looking for ways to minister to our children and will notify our church family when safe decisions are reached. During this time please feel free to bring materials for your children to use to keep occupied during the service.
4. I ask that each of you respect the concerns of other members, especially the elderly - **“Just use common sense.”**
 - A. Face masks are **not required**, but certainly **optional**.
 - B. If you think someone will be uncomfortable around you because you are not covered by a mask, then keep your distance or pull up your mask.
 - C. You can use a **scarf or bandana** or other form of covering. **“Be respectful of others.”**
5. I will conduct Baptismal Services one person per service unless they are family.
6. No paper, pens or printouts until Covid-19 calms down a little more. If you need offering envelopes, call Debbie at 270-877-2311.
7. Invitation will be given, but instead of physically coming forward, call my cell # **(270-763-3223)** and I can safely talk and pray with you.
8. The “Lord’s Supper” elements are still on back-order. When they come in, we will observe the “Holy Ordinance”. (They say those kits do not taste good.)
9. Our church **will be sanitized** after each service. We have a disinfectant fogger and will wipe down pews.
10. No Greeters. Security Team will point out seating for you. Families can be seated together in the same pew. Because of social distancing, every other pew must be empty.
11. No social gathering before or after service please.
12. Should you need to use the restroom, sanitation wipes will be available for you to clean door handles and any surfaces you may have touched. This way the restroom will be sanitized for the next person to use.
