

# Complacency?

In this time of face masks, social distancing, and an uncertain future certain people have taken these circumstances as an opportunity to prey on their fellow

man. I guess I am just old and jaded but I am never surprised at the depths certain individuals will sink to in order to enrich themselves at the expense of others.

Now is the time for all of us to be extremely vigilant as crime increases and our likelihood of becoming victims goes up. I have read numerous reports of various schemes and other crimes coming to light as the bad guys continually come up with new and innovative ways to separate us from our money. Here are a few examples:

Check your door mats. Criminals are placing a cookie under the doormat of a house they are casing for a future burglary. When they come back and check the cookie if it is broken, they know there has been someone walking on the porch and that the house might be occupied when they decide to break in.

**Fake testing centers.** Various groups are setting up fake virus testing centers where you can drive in and get tested. Unfortunately, this is a ruse to charge you for a fake test and obtain personal information which they will sell to identity thieves. These groups look so official they have even duped churches into letting them use their parking lots to set up in.

**Day light robberies.** I have seen reports of thugs waiting outside grocery stores and attacking senior citizens and stealing their groceries. This could be exasperated by a recent executive order which states that only one family member may now shop for groceries. If you end up being the lone shopper, I highly recommend you be aware of your surroundings and carry pepper spray or other defensive devices. But remember a cart full of groceries is not worth losing your life over.

Internet scams. You may receive e-mails that look very official like from the CDC or the World Health Organization. First, ask yourself why is the CDC sending me an e-mail? Exactly. They are not. These e-mails are deigned to infect your computer with malware. So, just like a ten-year-old jar of sauerkraut, "Don't Open It!"
