"THE KING IS COMING"

THE PROPHETS PROCLAIMED "THE KING IS COMING" JESUS - THE KING OF THE NEW COVENANT

Jer 31:31-34 NIV

"THE TIME IS COMING," declares the LORD, "when I will make a NEW COVENANT with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah. It will not be like the covenant I made with their forefathers when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt, because THEY BROKE MY COVENANT, though I was a husband to them," declares the LORD. "THIS IS THE COVENANT I will make with the house of Israel after that time," declares the LORD. "I will put MY LAW in their MINDS and WRITE it on THEIR HEARTS. I WILL BE THEIR GOD, and they will be MY PEOPLE. 1 Pet 2:6-8 NIV

For in Scripture it says (Isa 28:16): "See, I lay a Stone in Zion, a <u>CHOSEN</u> and <u>PRECIOUS</u> Cornerstone, and the one who <u>TRUSTS IN HIM</u> will never be put to shame." THE <u>PROPHETS</u> PAINTED A VERY <u>GRUESOME</u> PHYSICAL <u>PICTURE</u> OF THE <u>PERSON</u> OF <u>JESUS</u> ***

Isa 53:2-3 NIV

He grew up before Him like a tender shoot, and like a root out of dry ground. He had no beauty or majesty to attract us to Him, nothing in His appearance that we should desire Him. HE was <u>DESPISED</u> and <u>REJECTED</u> by men, a <u>MAN OF SORROWS</u>, and <u>FAMILIAR WITH SUFFERING</u>. Like One from whom men hide their faces <u>HE WAS DESPISED</u>, and <u>WE ESTEEMED HIM NOT</u>.

Ps 69:7-8 NIV

For <u>I ENDURE SCORN</u> for <u>YOUR SAKE</u>, and <u>SHAME</u> covers <u>MY FACE</u>. <u>I AM</u> a <u>STRANGER</u> to <u>MY BROTHERS</u>, an <u>ALIEN</u> to <u>MY</u> OWN MOTHER'S <u>SONS</u>;

THE <u>Prophet</u> said that <u>Jesus</u> would protect <u>His</u> Children like a <u>Shepherd</u> <u>Protects</u> his <u>Sheep</u>

Isa 40:11 NIV

<u>HE</u> tends <u>HIS FLOCK</u> like a <u>SHEPHERD</u>: He gathers the lambs in His arms and carries them close to <u>HIS HEART</u>; He gently leads those that have young.

IN <u>HOLY SCRIPTURE</u> THE <u>BIRTH</u> OF <u>JESUS</u> = <u>HIS FIRST ADVENT</u> OR (COMING) IS <u>ECLIPSED</u> <u>ONLY</u> BY <u>HIS SECOND ADVENT</u> OR (COMING)

The Second Coming of Jesus Christ is the greatest single theme in Scripture. While there are <u>APPROXIMATELY THREE HUNDRED PROPHECIES</u> in the Old Testament that <u>FORETOLD THE FIRST COMING OF CHRIST</u>, there are more than <u>EIGHT TIMES</u> as many verses describing <u>HIS SECOND COMING</u>. In total, some <u>2400 VERSES</u> throughout the Old and New Testaments reveal God's promises about <u>THE RETURN OF JESUS CHRIST</u>.
