#1 PERSONAL FREEDOM "<u>REJECT SELF FOR THE GOSPEL</u>"

Acts 25:8NIV

Then Paul made his defense: "I have done nothing wrong against the law of the Jews or against the temple or against Caesar."

James 1:13-15 NIV

¹³⁻When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; ¹⁴⁻but each one is tempted when, <u>BY HIS OWN EVIL DESIRE</u>, he is dragged away and enticed. ¹⁵⁻Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.

#3 PERSONAL FEARS

"FIGHT YOUR GOLIATHS"

1 Sam 17:45-47 NIV

⁴⁵⁻ David said to the Philistine, "You come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you <u>IN THE NAME OF THE LORD ALMIGHTY</u>, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. ⁴⁶⁻ This day <u>THE LORD WILL</u> <u>HAND YOU OVER TO ME</u>, and I'll strike you down and cut off your head. Today I will give the carcasses of the Philistine army to the birds of the air and the beasts of the earth, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel. ⁴⁷⁻ All those gathered here will know that it is <u>NOT BY SWORD OR SPEAR</u> that <u>THE LORD SAVES</u>; for the <u>BATTLE IS THE LORD'S</u>, and he will give all of you into our hands."
